



# WHAT'S IN YOUR HAND?

When God showed Moses the rod in his hand he learned this was all he needed to accomplish everything God sent him to do. God took what Moses did naturally (shepherding sheep), added His super to it, and it became supernatural! Partnering with God makes all the difference. God has also placed something in your hand. **Exodus 4:1-4:** And Moses answered and said, But, behold, they will not believe me, nor hearken unto my voice: for they will say, The LORD hath not appeared unto thee. <sup>2</sup> And the LORD said unto him, What *is* that in thine **hand?** And he said, A rod. <sup>3</sup> And he said, Cast it on the ground. And he cast it on the ground, and it became a serpent; and Moses fled from before it. <sup>4</sup> And the LORD said unto Moses, Put forth thine **hand**, and take it by the tail. And he put forth his **hand**, and caught it, and it became a rod in his **hand**:

Moses was unaware that God had pre-loaded ten miracles into this same staff!  
“When Pharaoh shall speak unto you, saying, Shew a miracle for you: then thou shalt say unto Aaron,

Take thy rod, and cast it before Pharaoh, and it shall become a serpent.

And Moses and Aaron went in unto Pharaoh, and they did so as the LORD had commanded: and Aaron cast down his rod before Pharaoh, and before his servants, and it became a serpent.

**Moses released Ten Plagues by the Holy Spirit:** 1) Water to Blood, 2) Frogs, 3) Gnats or Lice, 4) Flies, 5) Livestock Diseased, 6) Boils, 7) Thunder and Hail, 8) Locust, 9) Darkness, 10) Death of the Firstborn.

**The Bible records using the word Hand 1,470 times in 1296 verses.**

**Deuteronomy 28:12** The LORD shall open unto thee his good treasure, the heaven to give the rain unto thy land in his season, AND TO BLESS ALL THE WORK OF THINE HAND: and thou shalt lend unto many nations, and thou shalt not borrow.

**God stilled an evil spirit through the harp in King David's hand. 1 Samuel 16:16**

Let our lord now command thy servants, *which are* before thee, to seek out a man, *who is* a cunning player on an **harp**: and it shall come to pass, when the evil spirit from God is upon thee, that he shall play with his hand, and thou shalt be well.

**The little boy had two fish and five loaves in his hand.** When he partnered with Jesus, it fed 5,000 men and God gave him back twelve baskets full. **Matthew 14:17-21** "We have here only five loaves of bread and two fish," they answered. <sup>18</sup> "Bring them here to me," he said. <sup>19</sup> And he directed the people to sit down on the grass. Taking the five

loaves and the two fish and looking up to heaven, he gave thanks and broke the loaves. Then he gave them to the disciples, and the disciples gave them to the people. <sup>20</sup> They all ate and were satisfied, and the disciples picked up twelve basketfuls of broken pieces that were left over. <sup>21</sup> The number of those who ate was about five thousand men, besides women and children.

**The widow with a handful of flour and a cruse of oil--1 Kings 17:8-15** Then the word of the LORD came to him: <sup>9</sup> "Go at once to Zarephath of Sidon and stay there. I have commanded a widow in that place to supply you with food." <sup>10</sup> So he went to Zarephath. When he came to the town gate, a widow was there gathering sticks. He called to her and asked, "Would you bring me a little water in a jar so I may have a drink?" <sup>11</sup> As she was going to get it, he called, "And bring me, please, a piece of bread." <sup>12</sup> "As surely as the LORD your God lives," she replied, "I don't have any bread-- only a handful of flour in a jar and a little oil in a jug. I am gathering a few sticks to take home and make a meal for myself and my son, that we may eat it-- and die." <sup>13</sup> Elijah said to her, "Don't be afraid. Go home and do as you have said. But first make a small cake of bread for me from what you have and bring it to me, and then make something for yourself and your son." <sup>14</sup> For this is what the LORD, the God of Israel, says: "The jar of flour will not be used up and the jug of oil will not run dry until the day the LORD gives rain on the land." <sup>15</sup> She went away and did as Elijah had told her. So there was food every day for Elijah and for the woman and her family.

**Widow with only a little bit of oil--2 Kings 4:1-7** The wife of a man from the company of the prophets cried out to Elisha, "Your servant my husband is dead, and you know that he revered the LORD. But now his creditor is coming to take my two boys as his slaves." <sup>2</sup> Elisha replied to her, "How can I help you? Tell me, what do you have in your house?" "Your servant has nothing there at all," she said, "except a little oil." <sup>3</sup> Elisha said, "Go around and ask all your neighbors for empty jars. Don't ask for just a few." <sup>4</sup> Then go inside and shut the door behind you and your sons. Pour oil into all the jars, and as each is filled, put it to one side." <sup>5</sup> She left him and afterward shut the door behind her and her sons. They brought the jars to her and she kept pouring. <sup>6</sup> When all the jars were full, she said to her son, "Bring me another one." But he replied, "There is not a jar left." Then the oil stopped flowing. <sup>7</sup> She went and told the man of God, and he said, "Go, sell the oil and pay your debts. You and your sons can live on what is left."

**Artistic gifting for silver, gold, cutting of stones, wood carving-- Exodus 35:30-35** Then Moses said to the Israelites, "See, the LORD has chosen Bezalel son of Uri, the son of Hur, of the tribe of Judah, <sup>31</sup> and he has filled him with the Spirit of God, with skill, ability and knowledge in all kinds of crafts-- <sup>32</sup> to make artistic designs for work in gold, silver and bronze, <sup>33</sup> to cut and set stones, to work in wood and to engage in all kinds of artistic craftsmanship. <sup>34</sup> And he has given both him and Oholiab son of Ahisamach, of the tribe of Dan, the ability to teach others. <sup>35</sup> He has filled them with skill to do all kinds of work as craftsmen, designers, embroiderers in blue, purple and scarlet yarn and fine linen, and weavers-- all of them master craftsmen and designers.

**Gifted for war-- 2 Samuel 22:35** He teacheth my **hands to war**; so that a bow of steel is broken by mine arms.

**Clay Pots and Torches-- Judges 7:18-22** When I blow with a trumpet, I and all that *are* with me, then blow ye the trumpets also on every side of all the camp, and say,, *The sword* of the LORD, and of **Gideon**.<sup>19</sup> So **Gideon**, and the hundred men that *were* with him, came unto the outside of the camp in the beginning of the middle watch; and they had but newly set the watch: and they blew the trumpets, and brake the pitchers that *were* in their hands.<sup>20</sup> And the three companies blew the trumpets, and brake the pitchers, and held the lamps in their left hands, and the trumpets in their right hands to blow *withal*: and they cried, The sword of the LORD, and of **Gideon**.<sup>21</sup> And they stood every man in his place round about the camp: and all the host ran, and cried, and fled.<sup>22</sup> And the three hundred blew the trumpets, and the LORD set every man's sword against his fellow, even throughout all the host: and the host fled to Bethshittah in Zererath, *and* to the border of Abelmeholah, unto Tabbath.

**Jawbone of a donkey-- Judges 15:15-16** And he found a new **jawbone** of an ass, and put forth his hand, and took it, and slew a thousand men therewith.<sup>16</sup> And Samson said, With the **jawbone** of an ass, heaps upon heaps, with the jaw of an ass have I slain a thousand men.

**Musical Gifting--2 Samuel 6:5** And David and all the house of Israel played before the LORD on all manner of *instruments made of fir wood*, even on **harps**, and on psalteries, and on timbrels, and on cornets, and on cymbals.

**Martin Luther** had an ink pen and parchment in his hand, he partnered with God and wrote 95 statements the Holy Spirit gave him down on paper, pounded this into the Castle Church door in Wittenburg, Germany in 1511, and the reformation began that changed things forever!

**Martin Luther King had nothing but an ink pen and a voice**, he had a dream from God, they partnered, and Equal Rights were birthed into the earth in the 1960's.

**The Prophets and Apostles had ink pens in their hands**, partnered with God and wrote the Bible! 39 different authors, 1400 years, 66 books, one partner, God!

**Water to Wine--**The servants brought clay jars filled with water in their hands to Jesus, after partnering with him, the water turned to wine! (John 2:1-11).

**Paul had handkerchiefs and aprons in his hands**, when he partnered with God and prayed over these, they cast out demons and healed the sick (Acts 19:11-12).
